Knockin' Doorz Down Philanthropist of The Year Presented by 51FIFTY

The West Coast Stock Car / Motorsports Hall of Fame Committee, partnered with 51FIFTY Enterprises, are on the lookout for nominees for this years Knockin' Doorz Down Philanthropist of The Year award recipient for 2022.

This award recognizes an individual that has demonstrated a commitment to the west coast racing community, and has displayed a heart for giving back to others. This award honors an individual who has exhibited significant charitable giving or involvement, insightful leadership and volunteerism, and who encourages others to contribute. This individual continually sets the bar for excellence in community leadership and represents the change-makers we all aspire to be.

"The West Coast Stock Car/Motorsports Hall of Fame was pleased to honor Mike Curb as the first Knockin Doorz Down Philanthropist of the Year in 2021," said Ken Clapp, Chairman and CEO of the organization. "Mike, a 2006 inductee, was an early and continuing sponsor of the West Coast Stock Car/Motorsports Hall of Fame and among those friends whose support has contributed greatly to our charitable efforts.

"Philanthropy, however, isn't only about monetary stewardship. The contributions of time and the sharing of insights designed to grow the West Coast's motorsports industry is equally important."

The June 9 Induction gala, presented by World Wide Technology Raceway at Gateway, moves to its new home in 2022 – Sonoma Raceway's VIP/Hospitality complex outside the road course's iconic Turn 11. It marks the first time the West Coast Stock Car/Motorsports Hall of Fame's annual event will be held at a facility hosting a NASCAR Cup Series weekend. Sonoma Raceway also will host the NASCAR Camping World Truck Series and ARCA Menards Series West.

"Marcus Smith and the entire Speedway Motorsports staff have extended a red carpet welcome to the West Coast Stock Car/Motorsports Hall of Fame," said Clapp. "We are honored to be the first major event to be hosted in the complex."

Five members of the Class of 2022, as voted by the West Coast Stock Car/Motorsports Hall of Fame, will be announced during the March 12-13 NASCAR Cup Series event at Phoenix Raceway. An additional five Heritage inductees will be revealed in early April.

The West Coast Stock Car/Motorsports Hall of Fame was conceived in 2001 as a means of recognizing significant contributors and contributions to the sport of stock car/motorsports competition. The mission of the West Coast Stock Car/Motorsports Hall of Fame is to preserve history and heritage of the key role west coast stock car and motorsports figures have played in the sport's development and continuation and to recognize, through annual enshrinement, of outstanding individuals and groups within the sport such as, but not limited to, designers, engineers, mechanics, drivers, race track owners, promoters, publicists and members of the motorsports media.

The Hall is a 501(c)3 charitable organization, dedicated to supporting a variety of organizations and groups from coast to coast. During its tenure, the Hall has raised more than \$600,000 in the past five of its 20 years for youth, health and safety, hospitals, animal rescue, military and other charitable causes.
